## Tree Services

### Tree Trimming

All Hardwoods to be trimmed to the ANSI A-300 and Palm Beach County Standards. Trimming techniques are dependent on the type of hardwood tree. Contractor will **NOT** perform any "hat racking" techniques even at the request of the HOA. This practice is considered unlawful and detrimental to the health of the tree. Annual lift and thin to be performed creating a uniform look on all hardwood trees.

Price is to include the removal of all debris and the associated dump fees.

Over Guardhouse:

1 Mango- trim and remove mangoes

NE Corner of Bld. 46:

1 Ficus- deadwood; balance and thin

Over Gazebo By Bld. 25:

1 Ficus- deadwood; trim heavy on south side; slight thinning

NW Corner Bld. 25 By Previous:

1 Ficus- deadwood; slight thinning

South End of Park:

1st Mango- trim and reduce; bring down overall height

Middle of Park:

1 HW- slight thinning

NW Corner Bld. 31

1 Ficus- no thinning; lateral reduce sides from building and parking lot

West End of Parking Lot Between Bld. 29 & 30:

1 Callophyllum- deadwood; reduce sides; remove 1 low branch

North Side Bld.30:

1 Japanese Orchid- clean; reduce back from building and overall reduction

Entrance to Courtyard 30 & 32:

1 Carrotwood- trim, shape and thin

Between Bld. 32 & 34 at West End of Courtyard:

1 Ligustrum- trim, shape and reduce off building

West Side Bld. 45:

1 HW- clean sucker growth and raise

South of Grassy Area By Bld. 17 (By Ficus Removal):

1 Ficus- lateral reduce side closest to homes

NW Corner Bld. 40:

1 Mango- trim and shape

SE Corner Bld. 38:

1 HW- trim back from street light; bring down height

Front of Clubhouse:

1 Ficus- Trim off building; overall canopy reduction; balance and thin

Back Side Bld. 21:

1 Mango (larger of 2)- balance and reduce sides

East Side Bld. 18

1 Black Olive- clean/deadwood; thin; shape

Between Bld. 17 & 18:

1 Mango- balance especially of left side; reduce to balance

North Side Bld. 15:

1 Black Olive- thin and reduce off building

East Side Bld. 12:

1 Black Olive- thin and remove sucker growth

East Side Bld. 11:

1 Black Olive- shape and raise; thin and remove sucker growth

1 Black Olive- shape and raise; thin and reduce back off parking

South Side Bld. 10 (close to unit 211):

1 Mango- reduce off building

North End Bld. 21:

1 HW- shape and reduce off building

West End Bld. 10:

1 Mango- shape and raise; remove low branches over sidewalk

North End Retention Pond:

1 Black Olive- overall height and canopy reduction (leaves getting in awnings)

NE Corner Bld. 6:

1 Japanese Blueberry- lateral reduce away from building

East Side of East Pool:

2 Ficus- shape and separate from each other (no thinning)

North Side Bld. 1 #137:

1 Black Olive- trim off building; raise bottom; nothing on side close to electrical wires

South Side Bld. 4:

1 Black Olive- shape; raise; thin and reduce; remove suckers

North Side Bld. 8:

1 Black Olive- overall reduction, especially off building and parking lot; thin

West Side of Bld. 1 (South- Most):

1 HW- shape and reduce away from building and overall canopy

West Side of Bld. 1 (North- Most):

1 HW- shape and reduce away from building and overall canopy

**Tree Trimming:**

**Palm Tree Trimming**

Palm trimming techniques depend on the species of palm. Common practice is to trim between 9:00 and 3:00. All trees are to be trimmed to the ANSI A-300 and Palm Beach County trimming standards for each species. Removal of all seed pods and dead fronds included

Price is to include the removal of all debris and the associated dump fees.

This service includes the removal of one Queen palm from the front of building 16. Contractor will perform a flush cut as close to the base as possible. Pricing for stump grinding is available upon request. Price includes the removal of all debris.

This service includes the removal of one Queen palm from the front of building 11. Contractor will perform a flush cut as close to the base as possible. Pricing for stump grinding is available upon request. Price includes the removal of all debris.

**Ficus Tree Removal**

Contractor will remove one large Ficus tree on the East side of the dry depot. Contractor will perform a flush cut as close to the base as possible. Pricing for stump grinding is available upon request. Price includes the removal of all debris from property. Contractor may need to remove or damage the plants around the base of the tree in order to perform the scope of work. Pricing to replace these plants is available upon request.
